Interview

1) How does your home state influence your art?

I am influenced by places, climate, landscape, and environmental problems in CA. I was not born in CA though, and still frequently write about my birthplace, Philadelphia, PA.

2) What inspires you to create?

Many things. Artworks, personal experiences, newspaper articles, family history.

3) What is your art? Literary? Music? Drawing, painting, sketching? Photography? Film? Or other?

I write poetry, often ekphrastic, inspired by artwork, photographs, and other mediums.

4) Which creators influence you?

Many. I was originally drawn to the poetry of Stanley Kunitz and Elizabeth Bishop. These days I may learn most from writers like Ellen Bass and Dorianne Laux, but I read all kinds of poets as well as novels, and it all makes its mark on me.

5) How is your art (or art in general) important to society in the border states??

I come from a family of immigrants, and I frequently write about their earlier struggles in this country, coming to the US to a country that didn't necessarily welcome them at the time.

6) Is there a specific purpose for your art?

It depends on the particular piece.

7) Are there other artists that you collaborate with, network, or recommend?

I collaborate sometimes with artists and photographers. But I have also worked with editor Cati Porter, editor and chief of Poemeleon Journal, who has published two of my three anthologies as special issues of her journal.

8) Do you have a "real" job or is your creative work your fulltime gig?

I am retired from teaching. Currently, I host two virtual poetry series.

9) Do you collaborate with other artists/creators?

Yes, sometimes, as I have said above.

10) Tell us about an upcoming project you are working on currently?

I am not working on any particular project besides writing and organizing new collections and writing new poems.
